Three (3) signs are allowed to be posted in the city advertising such sales in addition to a sign installed on the residential lot on which such sales are to be held. Signs will be available at the city clerk's office. If other signs are used they may not be larger than the signs provided by the city. Such signs shall be erected no sooner than twenty-four (24) hours prior to the beginning of the sale and shall be removed no later than forty-eight (48) hours after the sale ends;

#### Sec. 14-45. - Definition.

"Garage sales" shall mean any sale or offering for sale of multiple items of personal property on property occupied as a residence. (Ord. No.

166, § 1(14-35), 8-8-83)

#### Sec. 14-46. - Regulation of sale.

Any person proposing to conduct or carry on a garage sale shall be subject to the following rules and regulations:

- (1) All sale items shall be limited to used domestic items owned by the applicant;
- (2) No one shall accept or take in for sale any goods on a consignment basis or any goods owned by another;
- (3) Three (3) signs are allowed to be posted in the city advertising such sales in addition to a sign installed on the residential lot on which such sales are to be held. Signs will be available at the city clerk's office. If other signs are used they may not be larger than the signs provided by the city. Such signs shall be erected no sooner than twenty-four (24) hours prior to the beginning of the sale and shall be removed no later than forty-eight (48) hours after the sale ends;
- (4) Not more than three (3) such sales per annum shall be held at the premises if occupied by the same family or any member of such family; and,
- (5) Any sale conducted pursuant to the provisions hereof shall be confined to the period between 7:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m. of any day and shall not extend in excess of three (3) days.

#### Sec. 14-47. - Permit required.

Any person conducting a garage sale shall be required to obtain a permit therefore from the city clerk. Such permit as required by this article shall be in lieu of all other permits or licenses which may be required by this Code. Application for such permit shall be made to the city clerk in such form as may be required by the city clerk.

#### Sec. 14-48. - Permit refused or revoked.

The license required by section 14-47 above shall be refused or revoked in the event that the applicant is found guilty of violating any of the provisions of this article or related ordinance(s), or the public good otherwise requires. However, the applicant shall be given a hearing before the city council prior to any such revocation or refusal.

## Sec. 14-49. - Penalty for noncompliance.

Any person violating any of the provisions of this article shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine of up to five hundred dollars (\$500.00), or imprisonment for up to ninety (90) days, or by both a fine and imprisonment, in the discretion of the municipal court. Each day during which any violation of this article continues or exists shall be deemed to be a separate violation.
