ORDINANCE # 451

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 11-78 DISORDERLY CONDUCT

ADDING PUBLIC INTOXICATION TO THE BLOOMFIELD MUNICIPAL CODE

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that Public Intoxication needs to be addressed in public places and could be detrimental to the public health, safety and welfare if certain safeguards and assurances are not made to the City ordinances; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BLOOMFIELD, NEW MEXICO, THAT:

SECTION 11-78 Item 13 Public Intoxication

13) Public Intoxication Any person who is drunk or in a state of intoxication or incapacitated by illicit drugs, alcohol, concentrated vapors, or inhalants on any highway, street, thoroughfare or other public place, or place open to the general public within this city, so that they are impaired physically, mentally or emotionally, to a degree that they are unconscious or too weak or too disoriented to be able to care for one's own needs or to recognize obvious dangers, or likely to be hazardous to traffic, either vehicular or pedestrian, or interfering with the peaceable use of the streets and sidewalks or other public property by other persons. Be added to the Bloomfield Municipal Code.
