Courtroom Etiquette

- 1. Defendants must be appropriately dressed and maintain a respectful decorum to be admitted into the Courtroom.
- 2. Court must remain quiet so that defendants and Court staff can hear.
- 3. Parent(s)/Guardian(s) of disruptive children will be asked to remove them from the Courtroom.
- 4. No cellphones or electronics of any kind;
- 5. No hats/head covering;
- 6. No halter/tank tops;
- 7. No exposed midriffs;
- 8. No low-cut tops, short skirts or dresses;
- 9. No pants hanging below the waist;
- 10. No inappropriate or distasteful logos on clothing;
- 11. No chewing gum;
- 12. And, no food or drinks.
